While some are born into utter poverty, some do not have parents leaving them to fend for themselves, while some others are born handicapped making them dependent on others for life.

The **Pratham Tyagi Memorial Trust**, established in 2006 in memory of **Master Pratham Tyagi**, works with the underprivileged children who dreams of a better future. Here, we believe in sustained efforts at ensuring a better tomorrow through our interventions in basic education, hygiene, medical care and vocational training. '**Saksham**' is a programme aimed at imparting skill sets to the economically backward communities increasing their job prospects. The Trust also provides computer education, books and stationery, school uniforms and other facilities free of cost.

By joining hands with '**Saksham**' you too can make a difference in the lives of the unwanted, uncared children. After all, every child is born with an innate promise and immense potential. We have an obligation to nourish it and see it flourish.





Education: Some facts and figures

- India's literacy rate is 65.38%.
- Male literacy is 75.85%, while female literacy is 54.16%.
- Roughly 35 million children aged 6-14 years do not attend school.
- Over 50% of girls between 5-9 years are illiterate.
- In 60% of the schools, there are less than two teachers to teach classes I-V.
- 2-3% of primary schools in India are conducted in open spaces or tents.
- 300 million people in India, that equals to the entire population USA, cannot read their own name.





Aims and Objectives

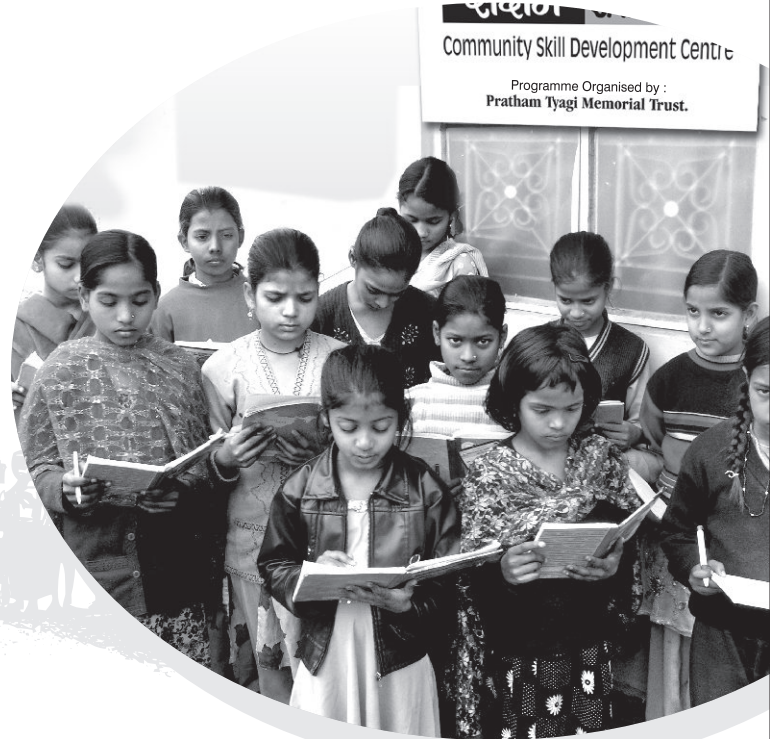
EDUCATION & TRAINING

- Conducting homework study classes for first generation learners.
- Skill development programmes with special focus on improving quality of life.
- Promoting learning centers in areas of child labor.
- Campaigning to change mindsets and initiate community action against child labour & economically weak.



FINANCIAL & OTHER ASSISTANCE

- Financial support for the education of underprivileged children between 4-16 years.
- Providing relief services for child beggars, rag pickers and working children.
- Promoting child artists and craftsmen
- Providing shelter for children in distress.

Success Stories

A physically challenged young boy Mukesh, 22, could never manage to pass an interview due to this unfortunate conditions, though he was proficient with the computer and many other IT skills like DTP to Tally. A brave heart, he decided to take his life head on and approached Saksham to further his training and capabilities. At '**Saksham**', Mukesh was given advanced and systematic computer training with other skills too. After completing the three month vocational training, he successfully got a job at an office in the Naraina Industrial Area, New Delhi and he earns a decent income for himself and his family. Today Mukesh dreams of enrolling himself for higher education so that he can get a better job.



Praveen was just 18 years when he lost his father due to cancer. With the sudden demise of the only earning member of the family, his mother and brother were left in dire straits with no one to turn to and nowhere to go. He heard about the 'Saksham' programme run by the 'Pratham Tyagi Memorial Trust' and joined the skill development centre for a short term course. Praveen was given basic computer training and provided with accommodation at the centre during the entire duration of three months. After completing the course, he got a job with the retail chain, 'Big Apple'. Today, Praveen is able to take care of his family and has enrolled his brother for his education. Praveen too wants to pursue higher education.
